The North Bay Science Discovery Day (NBSDD) is an event that fosters children's curiosity for science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM). NBSDD is brought to life by a dedicated volunteer committee of science enthusiasts, in partnership with the University of California 4-H Youth Development Program. In 2026, there were approximately 11,000 attendees, and 105 organizations offering more than 150 hands-on STEM activities.

Mission: Spark young people's wonder and curiosity about STEM; strengthen the San Francisco North Bay's STEM learning ecosystem; and connect the STEM industry, education, and public sectors to deepen and sustain young people's STEM learning.
